
Master- The hierarchical evolution of ethical aspirations and constraints.

Figure 7 These belong to the approaches to ethical choice. Clearly the highest aspiration is spirituality and the most basic constraint is the situational realities. The emergence of each level is based on resolving the duality of aspiration and constraint at the preceding level. This resolution serves as the constraint at the higher level, where a new higher ethical aspiration is invoked. (The term in bold is the ethical aspiration, and the term in italics is the constraint.)
